Beginning at the Southwest corner of this lot, at a post and pile of stones on the North side of the Government Road, from which point station "V" of the main road traverse bears by true azimuth $18^{\circ} 45'$ 24 feet, and the coordinates of the point of beginning are 3146.7 feet South and 31395.7 feet West of "Kapoho" Trig. Station, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2071, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $198^{\circ} 45'$ 1680.0 feet along Lot 8;
2. $319^{\circ} 00'$ 24.0 feet along Puua to Kukui tree;
3. $302^{\circ} 05'$ 1812.0 feet along Puua to 1840 flow;
4. $49^{\circ} 00'$ 1127.0 feet along Government Land to road;
5. $91^{\circ} 51'$ 275.5 feet along North edge of Government Road;
6. $86^{\circ} 10'$ 527.0 feet along North edge of Government Road;
7. $114^{\circ} 12'$ 280.0 feet along North edge of Government Road;
8. $102^{\circ} 47'$ 189.5 feet along North edge of Government Road, to the point of beginning.
