Beginning at a post and pipe at the Northeast corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Lot 11 and on the South side of the Kilauea Road, from which point the true azimuth and distance to a pipe at the South corner of Kilauea and Wright Roads is $239^{\circ} 31'$ 616.6 feet and the coordinates of said pipe at said road corner referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kulani" are 31075.9 feet South and 23349.7 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2411, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $329^{\circ} 31'$ 1438.28 feet along Lot 11 to a spike and post on the North side of the Volcano Road;
2. $53^{\circ} 54'$ 154.89 feet along the North side of the Volcano Road to a spike and post;
3. $149^{\circ} 31'$ 1453.44 feet along Lot 9 to a post;
4. $239^{\circ} 31'$ 154.15 feet along the South side of the Kilauea Road to the point of beginning.
