Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 913 and on the East side of "Road 4 West", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 17788.3 feet South and 885.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2650, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 265° 40' 1889.2 feet along Lots 913 and 912-A to an iron pipe;
2. 355° 40' 900.0 feet along the West side of "Road 3 West" to an iron pipe;
3. 85° 40' 1955.2 feet along Lot 1100 to an iron pipe;
4. 180° 04' 232.2 feet along the East side of "Road 4 West" to an iron pipe;
5. 179° 47' 670.1 feet along same to the point of beginning.
