Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northeast corner of this lot, the Southeast corner of Lot 918 and on the West side of "Road 6 West", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 17486.7 feet South and 3075.1 feet West, as shown on Government Survey, Registered Map No. 2650, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 355° 40' 1026.4 feet along the West side of "Road 6 West" to an iron pipe;
2. 82° 37' 30" 776.1 feet along the North side of "Road A" to an iron pipe;
3. 73° 54' 113.2 feet along same to an iron pipe;
4. 63° 59' 88.8 feet along same to an iron pipe;
5. 175° 40' 1123.5 feet along the Waiakea-uka School Lot and Lot 1006 to an iron pipe;
6. 265° 40' 968.0 feet along Lot 918 to the point of beginning.
