Beginning at an iron pipe at the Southeast corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 1012 and on the Northwest side of "Road A", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 21595.7 feet South and 12713.2 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2650, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 63° 00' 1049.0 feet along the Northwest side of "Road A" to an iron pipe;
2. 175° 40' 2145.1 feet along government land to an iron pipe;
3. 265° 40' 968.0 feet along same to an iron pipe;
4. 355° 40' 1740.8 feet along Lot 1012 to the point of beginning.
