LOT 10. BEING A PORTION OF THE GOVERNMENT LAND

OF WAHIAWA: WAIALUA: OAHU.

Commencing at a flat rock marked → on the south edge of a road (50.feet wide). From this rock the Government Survey Station Kokoloea bears S.64° 44'W. true and run N.35° 58'W. true 51.feet across road to a red-wood post at the south corner of Lot 10, The initial point of said lot , from thence running :-

1. N.35° 58'W.true 2418.feet along Lots 8 and 7, passing a red-wood post at 659.feet to a red-wood post on the south edge of the Wahiawa gulch; Thence -
2. N.82° 30'E.true 1480.feet along Grant 1092. to Paaluhi along edge of gulch to a red-wood post that bears S.82° 30'W.true 300.feet from a rock marked with a cross at the east corner of Grant 1092;
3. S.32° 19'E.true 1832.feet along Lot.12.to a red-wood post on the north side of a road (50.feet wide.) Thence-
4. S.60° 45'W.true 1206.feet along road to initial point.
