Station "Hakuma" being 7347.2 feet North and 4958.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2700, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $196^{\circ} 04'$ 120.00 feet along East side of a road reservation to an iron spike;
2. $286^{\circ} 04'$ 925.75 feet along Lot 105 to an iron spike;
3. $335^{\circ} 12'$ 158.67 feet along Government land to an iron spike;
4. $106^{\circ} 04'$ 1029.57 feet along Lot 107 to the point of beginning.
