Beginning at an iron spike at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 106, on the East side of a road reservation, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Hakuma" being 7347.2 feet North and 4958.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2700, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 286° 04' 1029.57 feet along Lot 106 to an iron spike;
2. 335° 12' 87.86 feet along Government land to an iron pin;
3. 52° 00' 66.16 feet along Grant 7121 to E. Akiona to an iron spike;
4. 106° 04' 1048.22 feet along Lot 108 to an iron spike;
5. 196° 04' 120.00 feet along the East side of a road reservation to the point of beginning.
