Station "Hakuma" being 7107.0 feet North and 4889.7 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2700, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $196^{\circ} 04'$  130.00 feet along the East side of a road reservation to an iron spike;
2.  $286^{\circ} 04'$  1048.22 feet along Lot 107 to an iron spike;
3.  $52^{\circ} 00'$  160.56 feet along Grant 7121 to E. Akiona to an iron spike;
4.  $106^{\circ} 04'$  954.00 feet along Lot 109 to the point of beginning.
