Beginning at an iron spike at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 108, on the East side of a road reservation, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Hakuma" being 7107.0 feet North and 4889.7 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2700, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $286^{\circ} 04'$ 954.0 feet along Lot 108 to an iron spike;
2. $52^{\circ} 00'$ 172.9 feet along Grant 7121 to E. Akiona and Grant 7127 to John Grace to an iron spike;
3. $106^{\circ} 04'$ 852.53 feet along Lot 110 to an iron spike;
4. $196^{\circ} 04'$ 140.00 feet along the East side of a road reservation to the point of beginning.
