Beginning at a galvanized iron spike and ahu at the Northwest corner of this lot and the Southwest corner of Lot 9, and on the East side of Mililani Avenue, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai", being 1463.0 feet South and 8691.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2566, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 270° 00' 200.0 feet along Lot 9 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
2. 360° 00' 100.0 feet along Lot 12 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
3. 90° 00' 200.0 feet along Lot 13 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
4. 180° 00' 100.0 feet along the East side of Mililani Avenue to the point of beginning.
