Beginning at a galvanized iron spike and ahu at the Northwest corner of this lot and the Southwest corner of Lot 9, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai", being 3143.0 feet South and 8251.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2566, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 270° 00' 200.0 feet along Lot 9 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
2. 360° 00' 100.0 feet along Lot 12 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
3. 90° 00' 200.0 feet along Lots 14 and 13 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
4. 180° 00' 100.0 feet along government land to the point of beginning.
