Beginning at an iron pipe at the Southwest corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Lot 12, Block 601, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 10644.4 feet South and 16195.3 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 175° 40' 900.0 feet along Lots 6 to 10 inclusive, Block 601, to an iron pipe;
2. 265° 40' 484.0 feet along South side of "Road 9" to an iron pipe;
3. 355° 40' 900.0 feet along Lot 13, Block 601, to an iron pipe;
4. 85° 40' 484.0 feet along Lot 12, Block 601, to the point of beginning.

AREA 10 ACRES.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 44/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 9-56/100 ACRES.
