Station "Hakuma" being 6828.3 feet North and 4809.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2700, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 196° 04' 150.00 feet along the East side of a road reservation to an iron spike;
2. 286° 04' 852.53 feet along Lot 109 to an iron spike;
3. 52° 00' 185.25 feet along Grant 7127 to John Grace and Grant 7126 to H.P. Morton to an iron spike;
4. 106° 04' 743.82 feet along Lot 111 to the point of beginning.
