Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northeast corner of this lot and the Southwest corner of "Road A" and "Road 5 West", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 18799.2 feet South and 1034.0 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2650, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 355° 40' 937.2 feet along the West side of "Road 5 West" to an iron pin;
2. 85° 40' 968.0 feet along Lot 1203 to an iron pipe;
3. 175° 40' 446.0 feet along Lot 1104 to an iron pipe;
4. 265° 40' 70.0 feet along Graveyard to an iron pipe;
5. 175° 40' 140.0 feet along same to an iron pipe;
6. 85° 40' 70.0 feet along same to an iron pipe;
7. 175° 40' 492.3 feet along Lot 1104 to an iron pipe;
8. 265° 40' 120.7 feet along camp site No. 6-C to a stake;
9. 175° 40' 41.3 feet along same to a stake;
10. 280° 36' 417.2 feet along South side of "Road A" to an iron pipe;
11. 283° 07' 29.6 feet along same to a stake;
12. 355° 40' 170.0 feet along camp site No. 6-B to a stake;

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13. 265° 40' 110.0 feet along same to a stake;
14. 175° 40' 135.4 feet along same to a stake;
15. 283° 07' 113.3 feet along the South side of "Road A" to
an iron pipe;
16. 273° 39' 114.6 feet along same to an iron pipe;
17. 249° 29' 87.6 feet along same to the point of beginning.
