Surveyed Description

Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Northeast corner of Lot 1114 and on the Southeast side of "Road A", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 21638.9 feet South and 12709.9 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2650, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 243° 00' 1049.0 feet along the Southeast side of "Road A" to an iron pipe;
2. 355° 40' 1740.0 feet along Lots 1112 and 1212 to an iron pipe;
3. 85° 40' 968.0 feet along Lot 1213 to an iron pipe;
4. 175° 40' 1335.7 feet along Lot 1114 to the point of beginning.
