Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northeast corner of this lot, the Northwest corner of Lot 1113 and on the Southeast side of "Road A", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 21638.9 feet South and 12709.9 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2650, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 355° 40' 1900.0 feet along Lots 1113 and 1213 to an iron pipe;
2. 85° 40' 968.0 feet along Lot 1214 to an iron pipe;
3. 175° 40' 1495.7 feet along government land to an iron pipe;
4. 243° 00' 1049.0 feet along the Southeast side of "Road A" to the point of beginning.

AREA 37-73/100 ACRES.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 10 feet wide for the flume across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 28/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 37-45/100 ACRES.
