Beginning at an iron spike at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 111, on the East side of a road reservation, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Hakuma" being 6684.2 feet North and 4767.9 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2700, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 286° 04' 614.68 feet along Lot 111 to an iron spike;
2. 72° 30' 580.77 feet along Grant 7828 to S.Kaleopaa to a cross on set stone;
3. 69° 35' 162.60 feet along Grant 5319 to M.Kalaemakani and Grant 6570 to J.Levi to an iron spike;
4. 196° 04' 417.70 feet along the East side of a road reservation to the point of beginning.
