Beginning at a spike set in concrete at the Southwest corner of this lot, the Northwest corner of Lot 12, and on the East side of road (30 feet wide), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaneahuea" being 1796.2 feet North and 577.1 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2813, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 205° 06' 159.8 feet along road (30 feet wide), to a spike set in concrete;
2. 336° 55' 91.1 feet along L.C.A. 9507 Apana 2 to Maikowai to a spike set in concrete;
3. 269° 17' 30.5 feet along same to a spike set in concrete;
4. 359° 53' 54.3 feet along Lot 9, to a spike set in concrete;
5. 87° 02' 134.3 feet along Lot 12, to the point of beginning.
