Station "Keokea 2" being 139.00 feet South and 407.81 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2814, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 45° 00' 146.00 feet along the Northwest side of a proposed 40-Foot Road to a pipe in concrete;
2. 167° 20' 133.67 feet along a 20-Foot Road to a pipe in concrete;
3. 240° 30' 77.32 feet along Government Reserve to a pipe in concrete;
4. 315° 00' 92.30 feet along Lot 12, to the point of beginning.
