Being a portion of the Government Land of Keonepoko Iki

Beginning at a spike and stonepile at the west corner of this lot, the south corner of Lot 12, and on the northeast side of the Government Main Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Reference Station "Village Flag" (marked by a 2" pipe in concrete) being 455.91 feet North and 338.79 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2370, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 233° 23' 200.0 feet along Lot 12 to a spike and stonepile;
2. 323° 23' 50.0 feet along the southwest side of Road Reserve to a spike and stonepile;
3. 53° 23' 200.0 feet along Lot 10 to a spike and stonepile;
4. 143° 23' 50.0 feet along the northeast side of the Government Main Road to the point of beginning.
