Being a portion of Lot 8, Grant 6174 to Wm. Henry of the
Keaahala Homesteads, Kaneohe, Oahu.

Beginning at a 3/4 inch galvanized iron pipe at the East corner of this piece on the boundary line of the land of Pau and Keaahala Homesteads, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "Collidge" being 1340.3 feet South and 1144.1 feet west and running by true azimuths:

1. 62° 45' 420.3 feet along the land of Pau;
2. 213° 17' 227.2 feet;
3. 217° 18' 116.4 feet;
4. Thence on a curve to the right with a radius of 60 feet the direct azimuth and distance being 267° 23' 92.0 feet;
5. 317° 28' 127.95 feet to the point of beginning and containing an area of 40,815 square feet.
