Being a portion of Lot 16, Grant 6174 to William Henry of the Kealahala Homesteads, Kaneohe, Oahu.

Beginning at a pipe at the Southwest corner of this lot, on the boundary line of the land of Pau and Kealahala Homesteads, and on the Northeast side of Road (20 feet wide), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Coolidge" being 1325.7 feet South and 1118.7 feet West, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 137° 28' 26.85 feet along the Northeast side of road (20 feet wide);
2. Thence on a curve to the right, along the Southeast side of road (20 feet wide), with a radius of 100 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being: 192° 12' 20" 163.3 feet;
3. 246° 56' 40" 100.45 feet along same;
4. Thence on a curve to the left, along same with a radius of 80.0 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being: 200° 13' 50" 116.5 feet;
5. 243° 31' 52.20 feet along Spring Reserve (Pres.Exec.Order 2075);
6. 264° 30' 132.0 feet along Lot 36-D; Kealahala Springs Tract;
7. 352° 10' 120.0 feet along L.C.Award 4173-B Apana 1 to Kahelelena;
8. 54° 30' 422.0 feet along Land Court Application 373 and Mahele Award 57 to Ke to the point of beginning.
