Being a portion of the Government
Land of Keonepoko Iki

Beginning at a spike and stonepile at the south corner of this lot, the west corner of Lot 11, and on the northeast side of Puna Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Reference Station "Village Flag" (marked by a 2-inch pipe in concrete) being 455.91 feet North and 338.79 feet West, and the coordinates of said Reference Station "Village Flag" referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "PAHOA" being 1527.1 feet South and 1467.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2370, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 143° 23' 50.00 feet along the northeast side of Puna Road to a spike and stonepile;
2. 233° 23' 200.00 feet along Lot 13 to a spike and stonepile;
3. 323° 23' 50.00 feet along the southwest side of Road Reserve to a spike and stonepile;
4. 53° 23' 200.00 feet along Lot 11 to the point of beginning and containing an Area of 10,000 Square Feet.
