Beginning at a galvanized iron spike and ahu at the Northeast corner of this lot and the Southeast corner of Lot 10, and on the West side of Manono Avenue, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai", being 1463.0 feet South and 9091.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2566, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 360° 00' 100.0 feet along the West side of Manono Avenue to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
2. 90° 00' 200.0 feet along Lot 14 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
3. 180° 00' 100.0 feet along Lot 11 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
4. 270° 00' 200.0 feet along Lot 10 to the point of beginning.
