Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot and the Southwest corner of Lot 11, Block 501, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 8809.7 feet South and 10056.3 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 265° 40' 484.0 feet along Lot 11, Block 501, to an iron pipe;
2. 355° 40' 900.0 feet along Lot 14, Block 501, to an iron pipe;
3. 85° 40' 484.0 feet along the North side of "Road 9" to an iron pipe;
4. 175° 40' 900.0 feet along Lots 1 to 5 inclusive, Block 501, to the point of beginning.

AREA 10 ACRES.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 20/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 9-80/100 ACRES.
