Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot and the Southeast corner of Lot 6, Block 801, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 14313.9 feet South and 10473.3 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 265° 40' 968.0 feet along Lots 11 and 13, Block 801, to an iron pipe;
2. 355° 40' 1080.0 feet along government land to an iron pipe;
3. 85° 40' 1210.0 feet along same to an iron pipe;
4. 175° 40' 180.0 feet along the East side of Volcano Road to an iron pipe;
5. 265° 40' 242.0 feet along Lot 1, Block 801, to an iron pipe;
6. 175° 40' 900.0 feet along Lots 1 to ⁵/inclusive, Block 801, to the point of beginning.
