Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northeast corner of this lot, the Southeast corner of Lot 1203 and on the West side of "Road 5 West", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 20631.1 feet South and 895.2 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2650, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 355° 40' 900.0 feet along the West side of "Road 5 West" to an iron pipe;
2. 85° 40' 1936.0 feet along Lot 1303 to an iron pipe;
3. 175° 40' 900.0 feet along Lot 1206 to an iron pipe;
4. 265° 40' 1936.0 feet along Lot 1203 to the point of beginning.

AREA 40 ACRES.

Excepting and reserving therefrom the Government Survey Trig. Station "Papohaku" and a lot 50 feet square surrounding same, (Area 06/100 Acre), together with the right to enter upon said lot and to occupy said Trig. Station, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 39-94/100 ACRES.
