2. 358° 00' 193.0 feet along the land of Kapunahala to a stake;
3. 76° 30' 275.0 feet along L.C.A. 3121 to Mahoney for Wake to a stake;
4. 166° 00' 168.0 feet along L.C.A. 3121 to Mahoney for Wake to a stake;
5. 85° 00' 153.0 feet along L.C.A. 3121 to Mahoney for Wake to a stake;
6. 239° 30' 123.4 feet along L.C.A. 4235:2 to Kane to a stake;
7. 180° 30' 158.4 feet along L.C.A. 4235:2 to Kane to a stake;
8. 192° 00' 198.0 feet along L.C.A. 4173B:2 to Kahelena to a stake;
9. 103° 00' 229.8 feet along L.C.A. 4173B:2 to Kahelena to a stake;
10. 268° 38' 147.6 feet along Homestead Road to a + on stone;
11. 261° 34' 166.4 feet along Homestead Road to the point of beginning.
