Beginning at a spike set in concrete at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 11, and on the East side of road (30 feet wide), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaneahuea" being 1796.2 feet North and 577.1 feet East as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2813, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 267° 02' 134.3 feet along Lot 11, to a spike set in concrete;
2. 359° 53' 80.0 feet along Lot 9, to a spike set in concrete;
3. 82° 07' 123.0 feet along North side of road (30 feet wide), to a spike set in concrete;
4. 172° 07' 90.8 feet along East side of road (30 feet wide), to the point of beginning.
