Beginning at a pipe in concrete at the South corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 11, and on the Northwest side of a proposed 40-Foot Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Keokea 2" being 139.00 feet South and 407.81 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2814, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 135° 00' 92.30 feet along Lot 11, to a pipe in concrete;
2. 240° 30' 102.77 feet along Government Reserve to a pipe in concrete;
3. 326° 18' 30" 74.64 feet along Government Land to a pipe in concrete;
4. Thence along the Northwest side of a proposed 40-Foot Road on a curve to the left with a radius of 430.28 feet, to the point of beginning, the direct azimuth and distance being 50° 39' 15" 84.79 feet.
