Beginning at the Southwest corner of this lot, the Northwest corner of L.C.Award 8435 to Keawe and on the East boundary of Lot 13-A, the true azimuth and distance to Government Survey Trig. Station "KA 1" being 76° 30' 1122 feet, and the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "South Base" (Hauula Homestead Survey) being 1012.5 feet South and 226.4 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2000, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 172° 40' 64.5 feet along Lot 13-A;
2. 167° 10' 42.0 feet along L.C.Award 10241 to Mahoe;
3. 248° 05' 101.0 feet along L.C.Award 10726 to Poopuu and L.C.Award 8338 Apana 2 to Kealoha;
4. 337° 30' 77.0 feet along L.C.Award 8438 Apana 2 to Keawe;
5. 255° 35' 36.8 feet along same to the Southwest side of the Koolau Railway right-of-way (40 feet wide);
6. 321° 55' 58.0 feet along the Southwest side of the Koolau Railway right-of-way;
7. 79° 25' 67.5 feet along L.C.Awards 10972 and 10975 to Waiauaia;
8. 78° 25' 113.0 feet along L.C.Award 8435 to Keawe to the point of beginning.
