Beginning at a galvanized iron spike and ahu at the Southwest corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Lot 15, and on the East side of Mililani Avenue, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai", being 2503.0 feet South and 8691.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2566, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 180° 00' 100.0 feet along the East side of Mililani Avenue to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
2. 270° 00' 200.0 feet along Lot 11 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
3. 360° 00' 100.0 feet along Lot 14 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
4. 90° 00' 200.0 feet along Lot 15 to the point of beginning.
