

Beginning at an iron pipe at the Southwest corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Lot 14, Block 501, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 8773.1 feet South and 10538.9 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 175° 40' 900.0 feet along Lot 11, Block 501, to an iron pipe;
2. 265° 40' 484.0 feet along the South side of "Road 8" to an iron pipe;
3. 355° 40' 900.0 feet along government land to an iron pipe;
4. 85° 40' 484.0 feet along Lot 14, Block 501, to the point of beginning.
