Beginning at an iron pipe at the Southwest corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Lot 14, Block 701, the coordinates of said point of beginning, referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 12442.6 feet South and 10816.9 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 175° 40' 900.0 feet along Lot 11, Block 701, to an iron pipe;
2. 265° 40' 484.0 feet along the South side of "Road 10" to an iron pipe;
3. 355° 40' 900.0 feet along Lot 15, Block 701, to an iron pipe;
4. 85° 40' 484.0 feet along Lot 14, Block 701, to the point of beginning.

AREA 10 ACRES.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 08/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 9-92/100 ACRES.
