Beginning at an iron pipe at the Southwest corner of this lot and the Southeast corner of Lot 11, Block 801, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 14277.3 feet South and 10955.9 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 175° 40' 900.0 feet along Lot 11, Block 801, to an iron pipe;
2. 265° 40' 484.0 feet along the South side of "Road 11" to an iron pipe;
3. 355° 40' 900.0 feet along government land to an iron pipe;
4. 85° 40' 484.0 feet along Lot 12, Block 801, to the point of beginning.
