feet South and 10640.4 feet West, as shown on Government Survey

1. 355° 40' 2184.1 feet along Lots 1312 and 1411 to an iron pipe;
2. 133° 25' 1741.4 feet along Lot 1413 to an iron pin;
3. 223° 25' 1160.6 feet along the Southeast side of "Road C"
to an iron pipe;
4. 240° 57' 270.7 feet along same to an iron pipe;
5. 264° 15' 66.0 feet along the South side of "Road C" to the
point of beginning.
