Beginning at a set stone marked "XII" between this lot and Lot 12 on the East side of 30 Foot Homestead Road, the true azimuth and distance from said marked stone to Government Survey Trig. Station "Rocky Hollow" being $66^{\circ} 31'$ 1196.3 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2293, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $130^{\circ} 00'$ 656.0 feet along Lot 12 across stream and up pali to top of ridge between Waiomao and Kekio;
2. Thence along top of ridge between Waiomao and Kekio, the direct azimuth and distance being: $224^{\circ} 30'$ 788.0 feet;
3. $301^{\circ} 10'$ 368.0 feet down pali along Forest Reserve to \dagger on rock in stream;
4. Thence down center of stream along Forest Reserve to "XIII" marked on large rock on edge of stream, the direct azimuth and distance being: $348^{\circ} 05'$ 440.0 feet;
5. $336^{\circ} 20'$ 999.0 feet up pali along Forest Reserve to rocky point on side of pali;
6. $38^{\circ} 20'$ 128.0 feet along Forest Reserve;
7. $130^{\circ} 00'$ 1013.0 feet down pali along Lot 12 to the point of beginning.

Excepting and reserving therefrom that portion of the 30 Foot Homestead Road (0.65 acre) within this lot, leaving a net area of 20.20 ACRES.
