Beginning at a galvanized iron spike and ahu at the Southeast corner of this lot and the Northeast corner of Lot 16, and on the West side of Manono Avenue, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai", being 1663.0 feet South and 9091.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2566, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 90° 00' 200.0 feet along Lot 16 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
2. 180° 00' 100.0 feet along Lot 13 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
3. 270° 00' 200.0 feet along Lot 12 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
4. 360° 00' 100.0 feet along the West side of Manono Avenue to the point of beginning.
