Beginning at a galvanized iron spike and ahu at the Southwest corner of this lot and the Southeast corner of Lot 13, on the North side of Leilani Avenue, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai", being 2603.0 feet South and 8351.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2566, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 180° 00' 271.16 feet along Lot 13 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
2. 270° 00' 100.00 feet along government land to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
3. 360° 00' 271.16 feet along Lot 15 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
4. 90° 00' 100.00 feet along the North side of Leilani Avenue to the point of beginning.
