Beginning at a galvanized iron spike and ahu at the Southeast corner of this lot and the Northeast corner of Lot 16, on the West side of Hinano Avenue, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai", being 2503.0 feet South and 9591.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2566, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 90° 00' 225.0 feet along Lot 16 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
2. 180° 00' 100.0 feet along Lot 13 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
3. 270° 00' 225.0 feet along Lot 12 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
4. 360° 00' 100.0 feet along the West side of Hinano Avenue to the point of beginning.
