Beginning at a galvanized iron spike and ahu at the Southwest corner of this lot and the Southeast corner of Lot 13, and on the North side of Lanikaula Avenue, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai", being 3443.0 feet South and 8791.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2566, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 180° 00' 200.0 feet along Lot 13 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
2. 270° 00' 100.0 feet along Lot 11 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
3. 360° 00' 200.0 feet along Lot 15 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
4. 90° 00' 100.0 feet along the North side of Lanikaula Avenue to the point of beginning.
