Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot and the Southwest corner of Lot 13, Block 701, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 12442.6 feet South and 10816.9 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 265° 40' 484.0 feet along Lot 13, Block 701, to an iron pipe;
2. 355° 40' 900.0 feet along Lot 16, Block 701, to an iron pipe;
3. 85° 40' 484.0 feet along the North side of "Road 11" to an iron pipe;
4. 175° 40' 900.0 feet along Lot 12, Block 701, to the point of beginning.

AREA 10 ACRES.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 34/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 9-66/100 ACRES.
