1. S 45° 27' 30" W 50.0 feet along Waiaka Street; thence,
2. N 44° 32' 30" W 108.2 feet along Lot 13; thence,
3. N 45° 27' 30" E 50.0 feet along Lot 15; thence,
4. S 44° 32' 30" E 108.2 feet along makai line of Wright Street to initial point.
