Beginning at the intersection of the Southwest line of Lot 9 Lualualei Homesteads (Grant 4751 to H. M. von Holt) and the Southeast line of Lot 13, said point being marked by $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe and ahu, and by true azimuth and distance $167^{\circ} 33'$ 9033.0 feet from Government Survey Trig. Station "Maililili", as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2165, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $77^{\circ} 31'$ 1970.0 feet along Lot 13 to 1-1/2 pipe;
2. Thence following a curve to the left along the East side of Government Main Road (50 feet wide), and 70 feet East and parallel to the center line of the O. R. 7 L. Co. track, the direct azimuth and distance being $352^{\circ} 57'$ 370.2 feet;
3. $346^{\circ} 40'$ 740.0 feet along same 70 feet East and parallel to center line of O. R. & L. Co. track;
4. $257^{\circ} 31'$ 1993.0 feet along Government Reserve;
5. $167^{\circ} 33'$ 1107.9 feet along Lot 9 (Grant 4751 to H. M. von Holt) to the point of beginning.
