Lot 14-A. Beginning at the Southwest corner of this lot and the South corner of the Long Estate, on the East boundary of the land of Wailupe and on the North side of the new line of the Palolo Valley Belt Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Wailupe" being 212.2 feet North and 476.7 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2313, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 209° 35' 418.96 feet along the land of Wailupe to a + on stone;
2. 284° 00' 57.00 feet along Lot 17 to a stake at the North corner of L.C.A.10169 to Mahoe;
3. 22° 35' 383.00 feet along L.C.A.10169 to Mahoe, to a + on stone;
4. 338° 27' 17.66 feet along same;
5. 99° 30' 122.80 feet along new line of Palolo valley Belt Road to the point of beginning.



2. 338° 27' 42.80 feet along L.C.A. 10169 to Mahoe, and pass-  
ing over a + on stone at 21.8 feet;
3. 37° 10' 167.50 feet along L.C.A. 10169 to Mahoe;
4. 129° 55' 175.00 feet along L.C.A. 3738-B Apana 1 to Kolihana,  
to a + on stone;
5. 209° 35' 102.54 feet along the land of Wailupe, passing over  
a + on stone at 68.5 feet, to the point  
of beginning.
