Being a portion of the Government Land of Keonepoko Iki

Beginning at a spike and stonepile at the east corner of this lot, the north corner of Lot 16, and on the southwest side of the Government Main Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Reference Station "Village Flag" (marked by a 2" pipe in concrete) being 429.07 feet North and 374.91 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2370, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 53° 23' 200.0 feet along Lot 16 to a spike and stonepile;
2. 143° 23' 50.0 feet along the northeast side of Road Reserve to a spike and stonepile;
3. 233° 23' 200.0 feet along Lot 14 to a spike and stonepile;
4. 323° 23' 50.0 feet along the southwest side of the Government Main Road to the point of beginning.
