Being a portion of the Government  
Land of Keonepoko Iki

Beginning at a spike and stonepile at the east corner of this lot, the north corner of Lot 16 and on the southwest side of Puna Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Reference Station "Village Flag" (marked by a 2-inch pipe in concrete) being 429.07 feet North and 374.91 feet West, and the coordinates of said Reference Station "Village Flag" referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "PAHOA" being 1527.1 feet South 1467.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2370, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 53° 23' 200.00 feet along Lot 16 to a spike and stonepile;
2. 143° 23' 50.00 feet along the northeast side of Road Reserve to a spike and stonepile;
3. 233° 23' 200.00 feet along Lot 14 to a spike and stonepile;
4. 323° 23' 50.00 feet along the southwest side of Puna Road to the point of beginning and containing an Area of 10,000 Square Feet.
