Beginning at a galvanized iron spike and ahu at the Southeast corner of this lot and the Southwest corner of Lot 16, on the North side of Lanikaula Avenue, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai", being 3443.0 feet South and 9478.5 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2566, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $90^{\circ} 00'$ 112.5 feet along the North side of Lanikaula Avenue to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
2. $180^{\circ} 00'$ 200.0 feet along Lot 14 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
3. $270^{\circ} 00'$ 112.5 feet along Lot 12 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
4. $360^{\circ} 00'$ 200.0 feet along Lot 16 to the point of beginning.
