1. 190° 00' 145.6 feet along Government Road to a stake;
2. 202° 27' 164.6 feet along Government Road to a stake;
3. 218° 30' 302.8 feet along Government Road to a stake;
4. 226° 17' 127.7 feet along Government Road to a + on stone;
5. 355° 00' 149.2 feet along L.C.A. 5820:1 to Kapunai to a stake;
6. 357° 30' 167.0 feet along L.C.A. 5822 to Koolau to a stake;
and L.C.A. 5820:2 to Kapunai
7. 85° 30' 77.2 feet along L.C.A. 5081:1 to Kuaiaia to a + on stone
8. 46° 13' 432.6 feet along Spring Reserve to the point of beginning.
